
Unsustainable redevelopment of the New National Stadium and its periphery

New National Stadium

Construction Cost: \$1.49 billion

Maintenance Cost: \$24 million / year

There is no plan to utilize the facilities after the Tokyo 2020 Games

To realise a sustainable society, it is essential that no one is left behind. For this to happen, we need to reflect the opinions of the youths, who are part of often marginalised community, to the process of policy decisions.

The voices of the youths here should not be a partial representation, but include as many voices as possible to maintain comprehensiveness.

JYPS considers delivering and reflecting such voices at the decision making process as one of its missions, and Today, we are here to deliver the voices of youths under 30 years of age we have collected, via surveys on SNS.

We will be presenting the results of the survey, however, JYPS does not necessarily agree to all of the voices collected.









On the scale of 1 to 5, how interested are you in the global environment?

地球環境に関する興味関心レベル






On the scale of 1 to 5, how confident are in your knowledge on global environment?

I don't think there have been any reports in the media that the Olympics or Expo are being planned in a way that respects carbon neutrality.



Positive Feedback

Because I had an impression that they implemented various measures, like the cardboard beds for the athletes. Also, I think it may have contributed to raising public awareness about solving environmental issues.選手用の段ポールベットなど、様々な取り組みをしているイメージがあったため。また、人々の環境課題解決意識を向上させるのにも役立ったのではないだろうか。

Items used were recyclable, such as using cardboard for beds. I think this would contribute to decarbonisation.ベットをダンボールにするなど、再利用できるものを使うようにしていた。これは脱炭素につながると思う。

I think there were some sustainable aspects, like the podium made of recycled materials. リサイクル素材の表彰台などサスティナブルな面もあったとは思う

Sustainable mode of supplying woods 持続可能欠木材調達

I heard that torches for the relay were lit using sustainably sourced energy.

Food waste

Because huge amount of food waste was problematised and requires significant energy to

dispose of food. Also, compared to the other olympic games, it did not even adapt to environmental issues. As an example, the majority of food served contained animal foods, which raises a question of animal welfare. 大量の食料廃棄が問題視されており、食べ物の処分にはかなりのエネルギーを要すると考えられるから。また、他国開催の大会に比べ、提供される食べ物の動物性食品の多さの点からアニマルウェルフェアの問題に加え、環境問題にも対応できていないと思う。

Seeing the issues with food waste, it made me think about the amount of CO2 emitted by burning the waste. 食品ロスとか見ると、結局廃棄物の焼却で二酸化炭素排出するなと思った。

There were news coverage on issues with bento boxes being disposed of お弁当廃棄問題がニュースになっていた

Especially food waste issues 食品廃棄の問題などの点

Food waste issues were covered in the news フードロス がニュースで取り上げられていた

I think it was very wasteful to dispose of the lunch boxes. (Because burning garbage leads to CO2 emissions.) お弁当の廃棄がとてももったいなかったと思う。(ゴミを燃やすことはCO2の排出につながるので)

issues including, but not limited to, significant amount of food waste 大量の食品廃棄など

I could not understand that they have thought about the environmental impacts, as seen in the issues with hosting the game in the most humid and hot time of the season, and food Wastealasanderonteshapeneronte

Food waste as a result of lack of planning 計画性の 無きから出たフードロス

PR

I have heard about something being done about it, but they were not advertised enough. 何か取り組みがあったことは聞いたが、それについての十分な宣伝がなされていない

(It was) not advertised, or promoted at a large scale. そんなに大きく取り上げられるわけでもなく大々的にアピールしていなかった

I felt that (the games) did not have particular focus on global environment. 特に地球環境に配慮した、ということにフォーカスを当てていないとかんじた

I don't think there were as much media coverage on the management side's consideration for the environmental issues. I have been watching the news related to the games, but I don't remember such coverage. 運営側の環境問題への配慮についてメディアの取り上げがそこまでなかったように思う。大会についてのニュースはそこそこに見ていたが、あまり印象に残っていない。

I couldn't think of anything more than the (production process of) medals, as measures to protecting environment.メダル以外 に特筆すべき環境保護の試みが思い当たらなかった。

I didn't get the impression that (the games) appealed (to the public) for a carbon neutral society. 脱炭素社会へのアピールが感じられなかった



Management

I think the games did convey (the message by) the use of hydrogen energy such as BRT, but with shortcomings such as food waste issues as a result of lack of planning, and skyrocketing budget for the venues, I cannot say that it served as a proactive PR to the public. BRTのような水素エネルギーの利用などのアピールは伝わったが、計画性の無さから出たフードロスや天井のない競技場の予算オーバーなど至らない点もあり、世間への積極的なPRにつながったとは言えないと思った

There isn't any quantitative evaluation about the process and results of achieving carbon neutrality, which makes the games not even a stepping stone for the future generation to decarbonise and meet the goal. カーボンニュートラルのためにどのような工程を行い、結果がどうであったのかの定量的な評価が見当たらず、後世の人間がカーボンニュートラル、脱炭素を行うための参考にすらならない。

Because despite there were some proactive attempt to decarbonise with installing fuel cell buses at planning phase, many other plans were scrapped in the end. If the facilities built for this Olympic games were not effectively used in the future, it can waste a lot of energy. 計画段階では燃料電池バスの普及など積極的な脱炭素への意気込みが見られたが、実現に至らなかったものも多いため。オリンピックのために作った施設を今後有効利用することができなかったら、エネルギーの無駄になってしまう可能性もある

The Others

The medals appealed as they were made of recycled materials, but because the coating came off and other problems, I would say the quality was lacking.

Used immense amount of electricity, and produced a lot of waste. 真大な量の電気を使い、大量のゴミも出た

Building the infrastructure contributed a lot in damaging the environment. インフラの整備は環境に負荷をかけた。

Saw an advert about the fuel station company while the games were streamed. 競技の放送中にガソリンスタンドの会社のCMを見た



Management/The Other

It's hard to visualise any system for evaluating the decarbonising measures taken in the process of hosting the event, and their outcome. As things stand now, it can be said that there is nothing the expo can contribute to solving the environmental problems. I could make a poem about it, but that wouldn't solve the problem, would it? カーボンニュートラル・脱炭素のために、イベント開催過程で何を行うのか、その結果どうなったのかを定量的に評価する体制がまるで見えない。このままでは環境課題の解決に万博開催が寄与する点がないと言える。(それっぽいポエムを詠むことはできるのかもしれませんが、それでいいのか…?とは思います。)

There isn't much mention about details on how they will address environmental problems.環境問題への配慮についての具体的記述があまり見られないから。

Because I don't think that carbon neutrality or decarbonisation would prevent the global warming in the first place. そもそもカーボンニュートラルとか脱炭素が地球温暖化防止になるとわたしは考えていないから。



Positive Feedback

Because I think the expo lends itself better than Olympics games, to address environmental issues. スポーツの五輪より万博の方が環境問題などについてとりあげやすいと思うから。

Because I am hoping that (the expo) would serve as a role model for the world. 世界のモデルになるような展示を期待しているから。

With high hopes, and believing that (the management would) listen to the voices of the youths.期待を込めて。若者の声を聞いてくれると信じて。



Tokyo Olympic × Protests





- A variety of people agreed with the petition and supporters amounted for 600 thousands.
- Reasons
 - Holding the Olympic under the COVID-19 pandemic is unreasonable since it is "the festival of PIECE".
 - It might cause medical collapse because more people can be infected and die(The number of infectors were increasing at that time).
 - The money to put off the Olympic should be used as the other expense, e.g. social security.

Demonstration

- About 500 people participated in the protest in front of Shinjuku sta. On 23rd Jun.
- The reason is almost the same as petition.



Why did these actions happen?

- The difference between the idea of Japanese government/IOC and that of citizens.
 - IOC has authority of cancelling the Olympic
 - Local organizing committees were afraid of the risk and miss due to cancelling
 - It needs to be paid that huge insurance
 - The government were worry about the relation of China(the next winter Olympic)
- ⇒The interests between stakeholders, such as IOC, the government, and corporations and citizens intersected.

Tokyo Olympic × Climate Action

Tokyo Olympic × Climate Action

- The happening is related to climate change problem in Japan
 - Japanese government usually opens public comment during a conference, but does not put them into practice.
 - Also there are a few opportunities that gather people's opinions.
 - The government has a right to decide policies, takes relationship between stakeholders and other countries seriously, the cost as well.

⇒That is why we put an ethical pressure on governments and companies.

How to avoid in the next Olympic

Suggestions



- 1. Making a process that put citizen's opinions into practice
- 2. Putting emphasis on citizen's voices and moving as they demand
- 3. Making Olympic more eco-friendly and sustainable
 - ⇒Be careful not to be greenwashing or make other issues

To improve the next Olympic

- The Olympic is "Festival of Piece"
 - Focus on not only current piece but also piece in the future.
 - It should not be made the conflict between IOC/the government and citizens.

• A host country should make decisions on the basis of Olympic Charter as a delegate.
