- 3. <u>Development and training delivery of a part of four CITC training courses</u> (GHGI, CCSD, MM and FECC <u>for Thai and ASEAN stakeholders</u> by TGO with support from JICA Expert Team
- 4. <u>Capacity enhancement of CITC training curriculum development and evaluation</u> for continuous training management by TGO with support from JICA Expert Team
- 5. <u>Establishment and enhancement of network of with institutions in Japan for sustainable CITC management</u>, through technical visits to Japan, by TGO with support from JICA Expert Team
